### **Record Number Of Exhibitors For APF 2016**

APF 2016 has announced that a record number of exhibitors have already booked for the show with still 3 months to go until it opens on the 15/16/17<sup>th</sup> September at Ragley Estate, Alcester, Warwickshire.

Exhibition Secretary, Ian Millward, reported “With still three months to go we have already exceeded the record set in 2014. 280 exhibitors have booked so far and more are coming in on a daily basis. Our static display area is now full and we have had to create some extra space on the demonstration circuit to cope with demand. There is the real possibility that we will sell out of space completely for the first time.”

The exhibition is not just for the big companies in the forestry, woodland, arboricultural and fencing sectors. Ian went on to say “We decided to offer the option of a slightly smaller and cheaper stand this year and this has attracted a lot of new companies who have not exhibited with us before.”

Companies from 12 countries all over the world, as far afield as America and Japan have booked and Ian urged any companies wishing to take part to book as soon as possible to avoid missing out.

## **Editors Notes:**

APF 2016 is a biannual event. This will be the 21<sup>st</sup> Exhibition. The first Exhibition was held at Longleat Estate in 1976. It is returning to Ragley Estate after being staged there in 2004, 2006, 2012 and 2014

The Exhibition is the largest such event in the UK and the 3rd largest in Europe. It is the leading exhibition for the forestry, woodland, arboriculture, wood fuel and utility sectors in the UK. Over 270 Exhibitors and 17 000 visitors are expected over the three days of the show. 90% of visitors are trade professionals working in the industry.

It showcases the very latest machines and technology being used in the industry as well as the largest display of traditional but still used woodland crafts found anywhere in the UK and displays of horse logging.

The seminar programme features leading figures in the industry speaking on topical issues of the day including plant health, pest and diseases, technology, safety and training, marketing, wood fuel and wood processing. It covers everything that is trees or timber related.

Over 2000 exhibitor staff and thousands of visitors will bring more than £1million pounds into the local economy during the course of the Exhibition in terms of hotel bookings and meals.

It features a 2040m demonstration circuit where machines are shown working in a realistic setting. With exhibitors on both sides of the circuit that is over 2½ miles of working machinery. An estimated £30 million pounds of machinery will be on show.
